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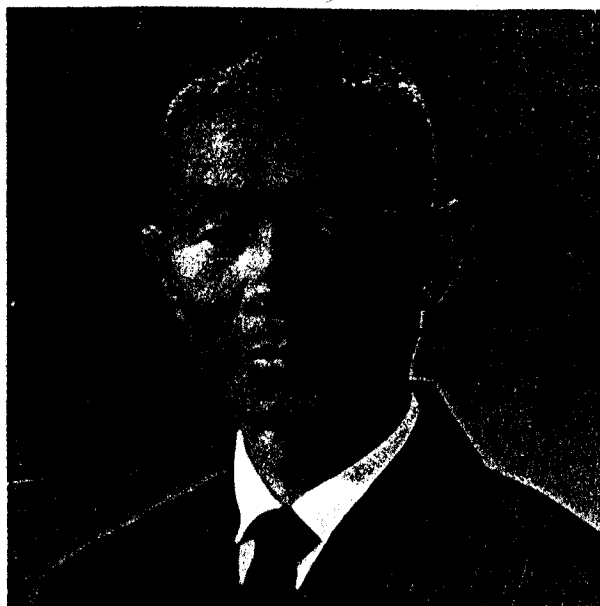
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#### About the author:

Kanjitsu Iijima, who was born in Tokyo, in 1914, graduated from the Buddhism Department of Rissho University and later studied at the Hartford Theological Seminary. In 1939, while living in Tokyo, he published a denunciation of the theory of emperor worship and, as a result of the persecutions of the militarist government who sponsored this worship, was forced to emigrate to the United States. In 1945, in New York, he gained recognition for admonishing the Truman government against the lawlessness of executing war criminals. He has lectured on the teachings of Nichiren Buddhism in many cities in the United States, including New York, Seattle, Sacramento, and San Francisco. In 1967, he established the Daruma Yoga Church Institute, in Los Angeles, which has been officially recognized by the state of California.

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
